

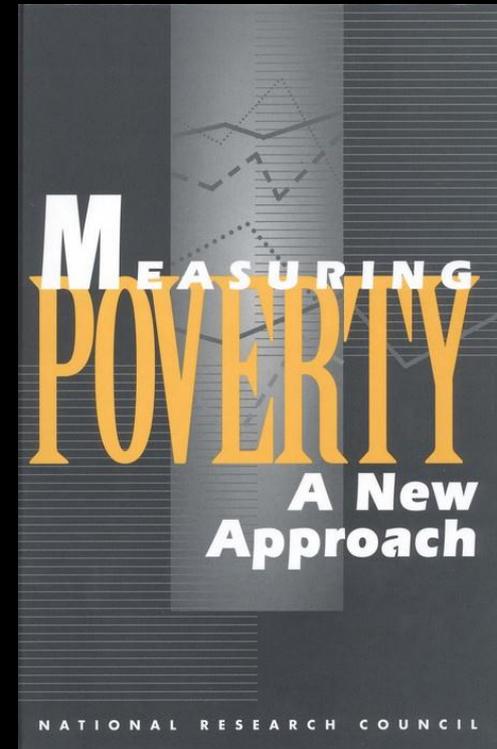

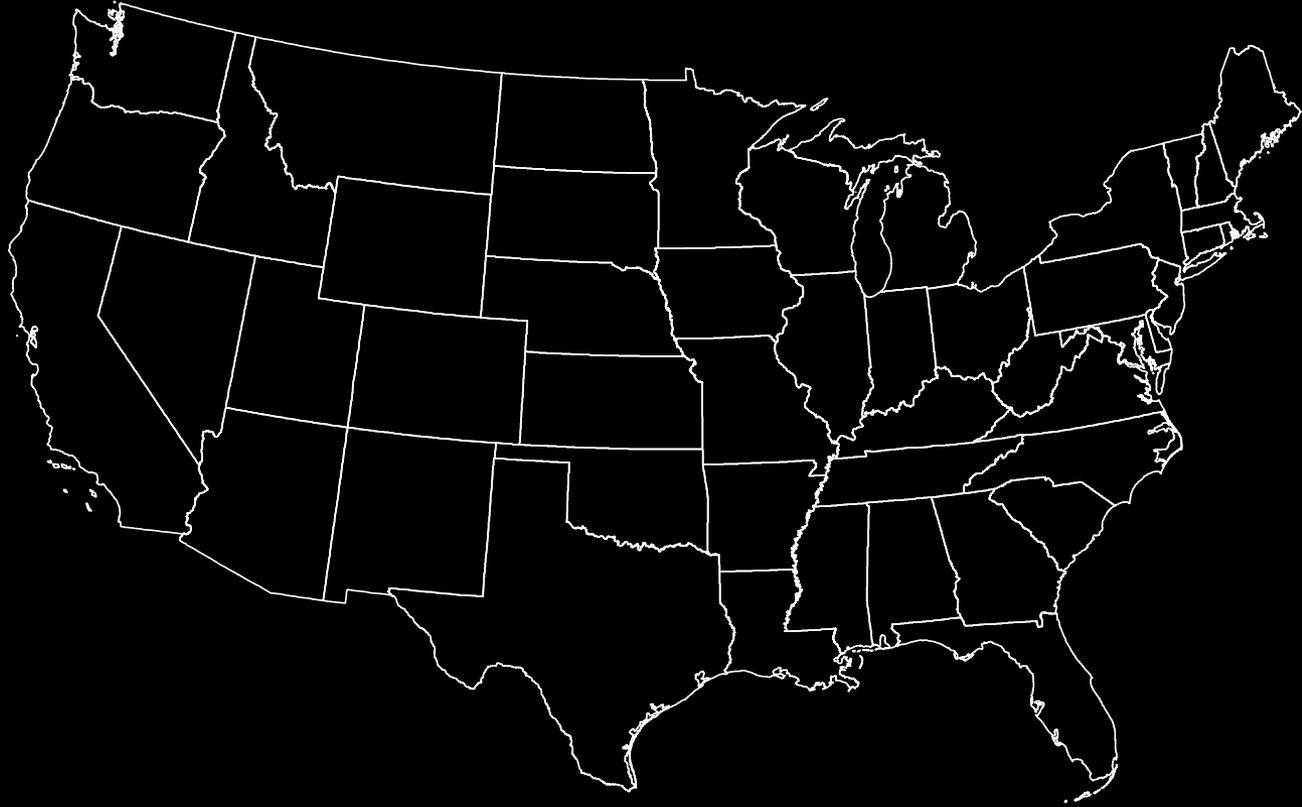
Measuring Poverty: A New Approach

Recommendations from the National Academy of Sciences for improving the official U.S. Poverty Measure



Official Poverty Measure

- 1. No geographic adjustments.*
- 2. Thresholds based on 1960s food costs.*
- 3. No accounting for medical expenses, taxes, and in-kind assistance.*
