Neighborhoods Matter to Universities?

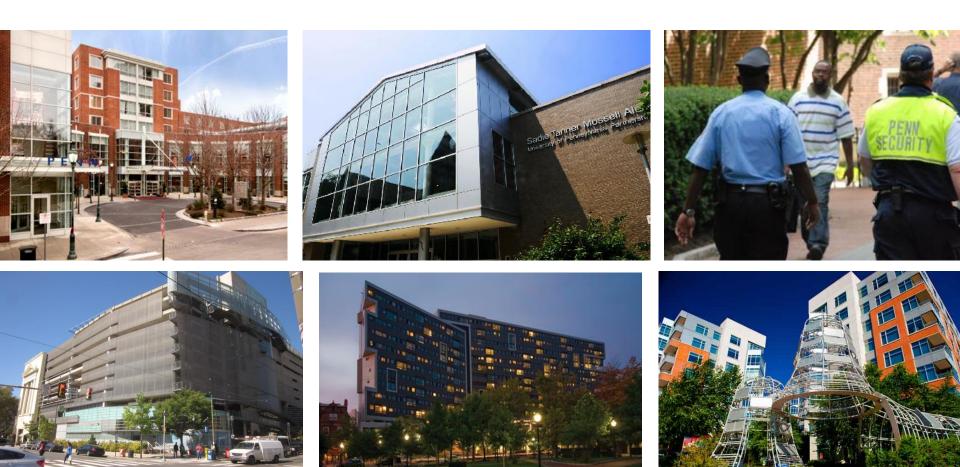
- Universities are investing in place

 - Emphasizing attraction strategies for university consumers
- Interventions are working
 - Stimulating neighborhood improvement via home values (20%)

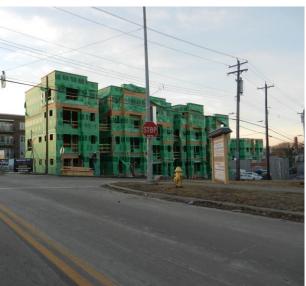
