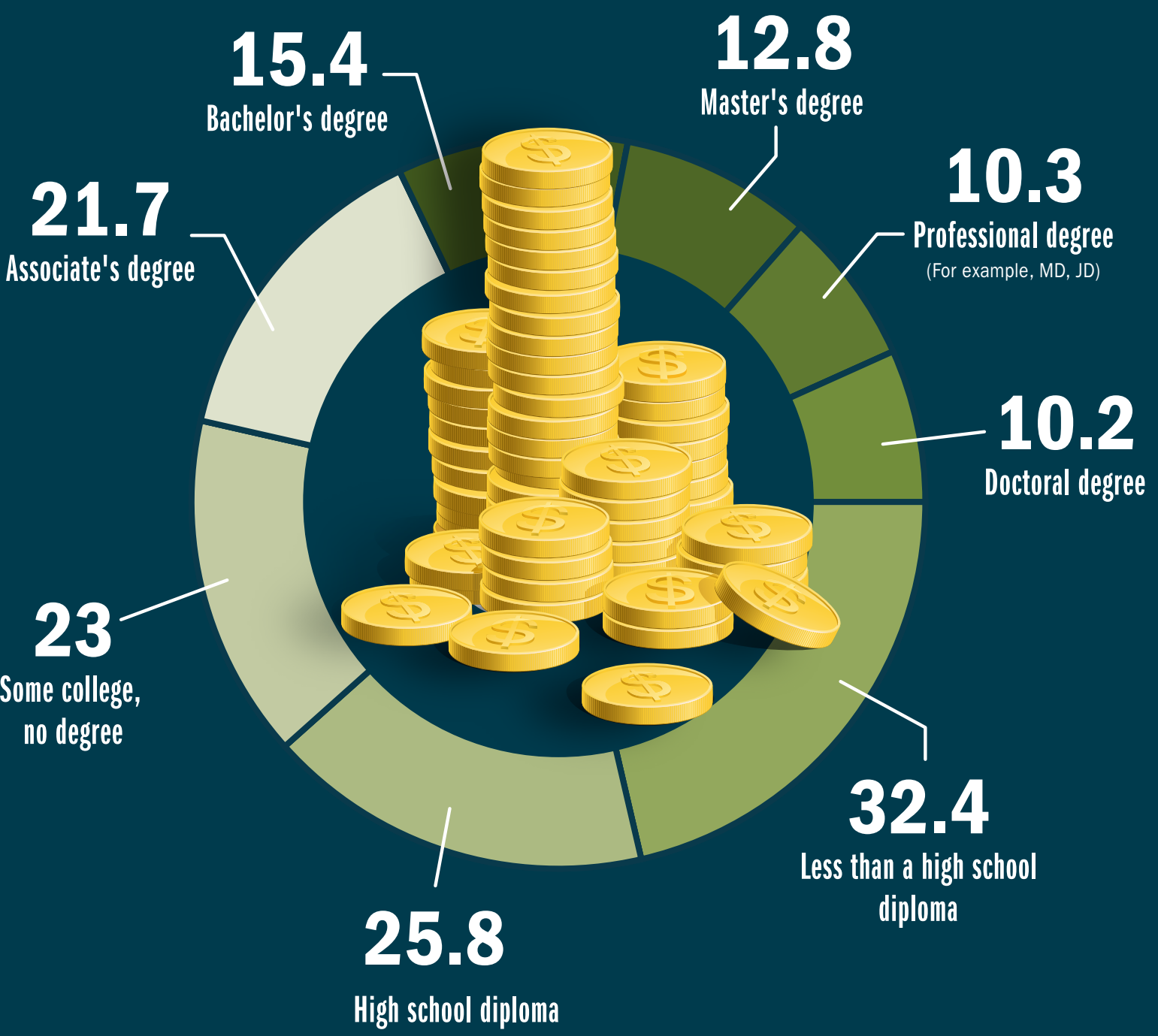
WHAT IS HUMAN CAPITAL?

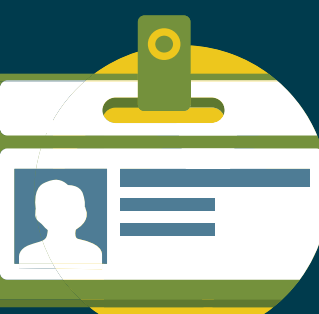

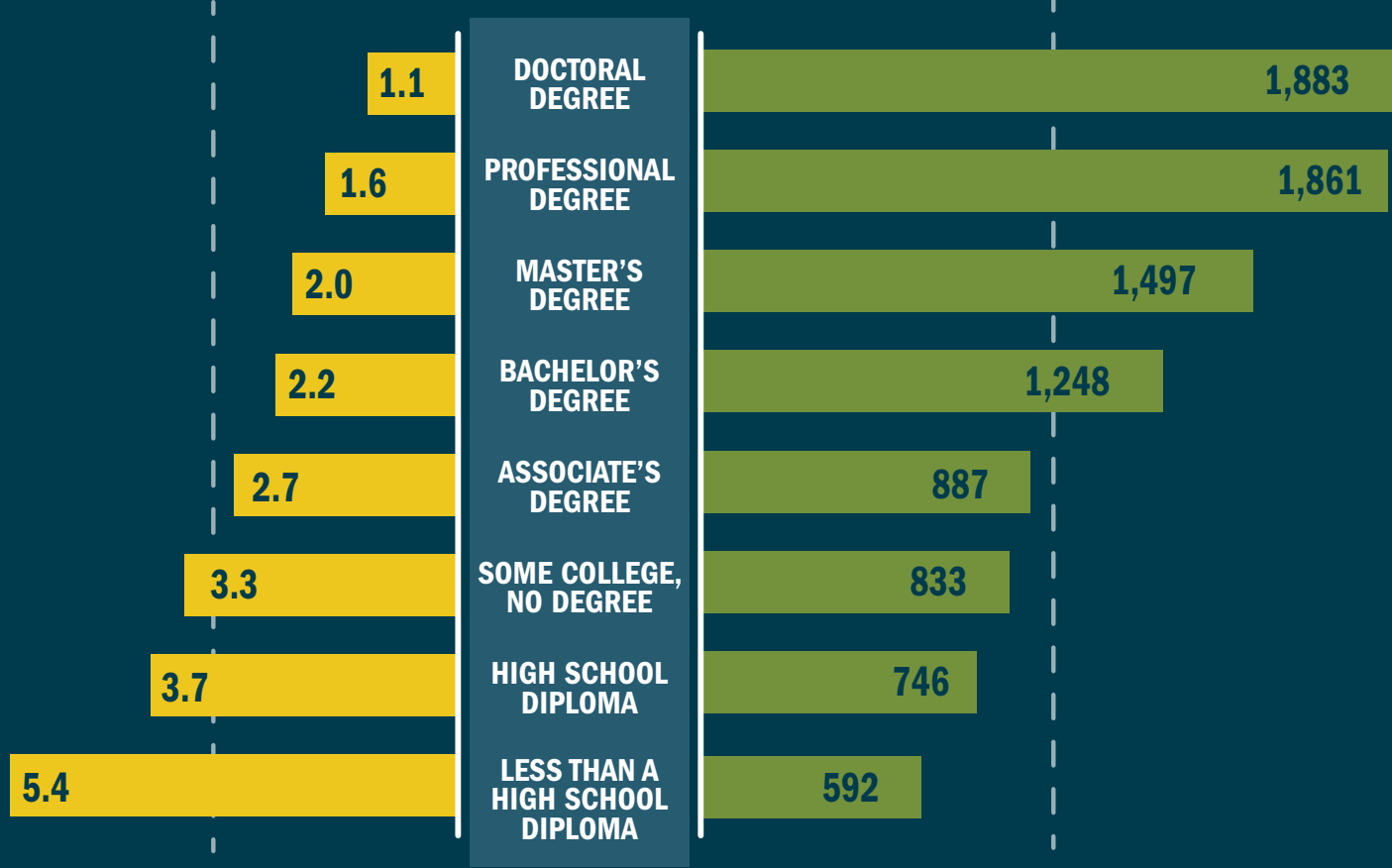
